During his summer vacation, he worked in a shoe shop for Rs. 5 a day and later in a textile shop as well, for earnings as small as Rs. 9/day in 1977. He thinks that someone who experiences lot of pains in the first innings of his/her life, will surely have pleasure in their second innings of life and vice-versa. The poverty he had was a blessing in disguise, and thus he had no fear of losing anything. Everything the world offered became opportunities and that let him to choose confident and positive decisions in his studies and career, thus becoming a first class graduate in Chemistry in Madras University in 1978. He feels the one fortunate thing happened in his life was he could not get a job in Coimbatore to settle even after four years of his graduation which made him to leave home and that changed his life to move away and look for new opportunities in Bombay. His inputs to parents are: trust the children, motivate them, appreciate them and do not discourage them. Worked in Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Mumbai for 14 years, as Research Scientist, before he left it to start a business in 1996 after completing his MSc and Ph.D., both in Thyroid Biochemistry from Mumbai University. He is the creator of "Thyrocare" which is a unique concept of single laboratory for the "Billion Population". His Vision is to serve to 50% of world's population for 50% of their diagnostic needs at 50% of the current costs.

Dr.A. Velumani: The Legend and the Leverage

Dr. A. Velumani, Founder, CMD & CEO, Thyrocare was very clear about the major choices which actually transformed his life through the life-changing decisions, including the one to leave his village and come to a city like Mumbai and later on, quit the relatively secured government job at BARC to embark on a risk-filled journey as an entrepreneur. He also mentioned about the support he received from his wife, late Mrs. Sumathi Velumani, in his life-altering decisions.

He gave a vivid and inspiring account of his life's journey from a small village in the state of Tamil Nadu to build a business which had a very successful IPO in the recent past, when he gave the keynote address on the first day of Healthcare Senate 2016. His speech was filled with several interesting anecdotes

interspersed with humour, an amazing combination which left the audience spellbound.

In a very candid address, Dr. Velumani described the struggles he underwent as the son of a landless farmer but also revealed that they made him a stronger personality. Thus, he believes that poverty can actually be a hard but an effective teacher.

Success Ingredients

- Without focus there is no success
- Be a disruptor or get ready to be disrupted
- If you are not ready to lose a million, you cannot make a billion
- Maintain TTT Trust, Truth and Transparency
- Experience is nothing but the number of problems you solve in the course of your life

He shared invaluable insights for the benefit of all entrepreneurs. He advised them to step out of their comfort zones and explore new areas of growth as only those have the courage to take risks and venture into the unknown would be successful. In his inimitable style he stated, "In life, there is "security" and there is "prosperity", but there is nothing which comes as "secured prosperity."

He explained the disruptions he ushered in the diagnostics sector by bringing down the cost of thyroid testing. He provides low-cost, high-quality diagnostics services with the help of people, technology and systems. His volume-driven model has brought in cost and concept disruptions. If replicated, it could serve as a great model of services delivery for Indian healthcare which is dueling with twin concerns of affordability and accessibility. Thus, he highlighted how cost and quality are not inversely proportional and how right pricing has a pivotal role in ensuring success. He also emphasised on Focus, IT, HR and Logistics as pillars on which a flourishing business can be built.

His address did not just touch on entrepreneurship but also comprised lessons on mentoring and parenting. He asked the audience to ensure that their wards and protegees are allowed to make their own

mistakes and learn though experiences. His quirky way of explaining his philosophies had the audience in splits, but they also found it to be educating and inspiring. The august audience of leaders and game changers at Healthcare Senate 2016 were very appreciative of his session and gave him a standing ovation.

Dr. Velumani Arokiaswamy, CEO, Thyrocare served as a panelist in an overview of current trends of the healthcare industry and how innovative business models, products and services are impacting its reach, efficiency, delivery, growth and progress in India which was organized by VCC TV in their Healthcare Investment Summit 2016.
