REVISITING NATIVE WISDOM

Human emotions are the basis for human behaviour. Emotions are expressed in words and deeds. Quite often, intentionally or unintentionally, words and deeds do not correlate. Thinking, a covert or concealed process of mind differ from action, which is an overt expression. Gauging hidden aspects of human behaviour thorough one's actions or deeds is perhaps the only method of judging people and their character. In other words, one's personality is manifested through one's deeds, actions or behaviour. This is eminently portrayed in *Arivup-pathu*, the ten condensed statements about the outward manifestation of inner thinking, mindset or personality traits of an individual. The original Tamil text as found in the Tamil ethical treatise *Muthumozhik-kanchi* and its translation are given below.

1. ஆர்கலி உலகத்து மக்கட கெல்லாம்
பேரில் பிறந்தமை ஈரத்தி னறிப.

For the people living on the earth surrounded by ocean, high birth of an individual is manifested in the love and grace that he / she shows towards the fellow beings.

2. ஈரம் உடைமை ஈகையின் அறிப

The kind hearted nature of an individual is manifested in the benevolent acts.

3. சோரா நன்னட்பு உதவியின் அறிப

The trustworthiness of friendship is manifested in the help extended spontaneously.

4. கற்றது உடைமை காட்சியின் அறிப

The knowledge possessed by an individual is manifested in the extent of its application.

5. ஏற்றம் உடைமை எதிர்கோளின் அறிப

The velocity of one's growth is manifested in the ability to face challenges.

6. சிற்றில் பிறந்தமை பெருமிதத்தின் அறிப.

Low birth of an individual is manifested in the haughty behaviour.

7. கூத்திரம் செய்தவன் கள்வனாதல் அறிப.

The thievish character of an individual is manifested in the deceitful behaviour.

8. சொல் சோர்வு உடைமையின் எச்சோர்வும் அறிப

All other weaknesses of an individual is manifested in the lack of firmness in one's words.

9. அறிவு சோர்வு உடைமையின் பிறிது சோர்வு அறிப

All other weaknesses of an individual is manifested in the mental weakness.

10. சீருடை ஆண்மை செய்கையின் அறிப.

The greatness of one's personality is manifested in the resolute action.
